**NEW YORK TIMES COMMUNITIES FUND**

The holiday season in America is traditionally a time of gift – giving among family and friends. It is also a time for many Americans to help others who are less fortunate than they are. One such charitable effort has been helping people in New York assist other New Yorkers for more than a century. Along with the smell of roasting chestnuts on Fifth Avenue and the sound of hand – bells rung by scores of Santa Claus look – alike outside the bustling Big Apple department stores, the reappearance of the *New York Times* Communities Fund is another signal for New Yorkers that the holiday season has arrived.

From the beginning of November until the end of January each year, the *New York*

*Times* newspaper highlights the **plight** of around ninety individuals who are down on their luck and could be helped through readers' generosity. "I think the unifying spirit here is one of civic conscience," says Jack Rosenthal, who administers the Communities Fund for the *New York Times* Foundation.

The fund was conceived on Christmas Day in 1911, after the newspaper's publisher went for a walk following a big turkey dinner and was approached by a hungry man asking for money for food. The kind – hearted publisher gave him the money, and the following Christmas, he asked his newspaper staff to find the hundred neediest people in New York and write stories about them. The publisher believed that New Yorkers, once presented with these stories, would sympathize and respond.

"That remains the spirit of this fund," says Mr. Rosenthal. Since **its** inception, the fund has received over three hundred million dollars from donors both large and small, reflecting the **diversity** of New York City itself. People from all walks of life have contributed to the cause. **The newspaper covers all administrative costs, ensuring that 100% of donations go directly to charity.**
